Campbellford Memorial Hospital receives Pfizer vaccinations

Campbellford – March 4, 2021 – Today, Campbellford Memorial Hospital (CMH) began vaccinating residents and staff of the Campbellford Memorial Multicare Lodge after being given the go ahead by Haliburton, Kawartha, Pine Ridge District Health Unit (HKPRDHU). Vaccines arrived at CMH this morning.

Once all residents of the Multicare Lodge have been given their first vaccination, CMH will be vaccinating our highest priority healthcare workers as per the direction of HKPRDHU and in accordance with the provincial phased approach to vaccination roll-out. The CMH COVID-19 vaccination site will be located in the Hospital's Main Entrance which has been closed since the beginning of the pandemic with visitors being diverted to the Hospital's ambulatory care entrance.

Close to 70 CMH staff have already been vaccinated thanks to Northumberland Hills Hospital (NHH), which has been serving as a central vaccination clinic for the highest priority health care workers in the HKPRDHU.
