TRENT HILLS, ON – April 6, 2021 – The Campbellford Memorial Hospital (CMH) Foundation is pleased to announce the *Ranney Gorge Run ~ Presented by Bay of Quinte Mutual Insurance* will make its virtual return this year.

We had hoped we would be able to gather together in 2021, but due to the on-going pandemic we have decided our run will be done virtually. The virtual run, in support of CMH, will give registrants the opportunity to run or walk anywhere they choose, between May 1st – May 16th. Funds raised will support patient care and the purchase of new life-saving medical equipment for CMH, such as a new Cardiac Telemetry Monitoring System.

Registration is open for the *Ranney Gorge Virtual Run* ~ *Presented by Bay of Quinte Mutual Insurance Company.* The 10.55K/5K registration fee is just \$25 and free for youth 12 and under.

Here is what to do:

- Set up your Personal Fundraising Page and ask your friends, family and co-workers to sponsor you to help fund the purchase of new life-saving equipment at CMH (You can also print off the Virtual Run Pledge Form and collect pledges to be given to the CMH Foundation)
- 3. Do your run/walk on the date, location and time of your choosing.
- 4. <u>Take lots of photos</u> and send them to us <u>or</u> share on your social media platforms. If you share your photos with the hashtag **#Ranneygorgerun** and your name will go into a draw for some AWESOME prizes!

This is a fun run! You don't have to worry about submitting your time; we just want you to get out, be active, and have fun. All participants will receive their race kit in the mail which will include a *2021 Ranney Gorge Virtual Run* branded t-shirt, finisher medal, and other goodies. Race Kits will be mailed at a later date.
